- After students have spent about 2 minutes to play with the letter tiles. Tell the students that we are going to try to figure out what the mysterty word is. Show them the letters on the Smartboard.
- Ask a student to come up and make the word AN. While that student is making the word on the board tell the student to make it with their letter tiles at their desk.
- Tell students to take away the N and add a T to the end. (at)
- Ask a student to come up to the board manipulating the letters. Tell students to do the same with their tiles (pat)
- Tell the students to take away the "t" at the end Add a letter to the end that makes the /l/ souund After all the students have maniuplated their tiles ask for a voulenteer to mvoe that same letter on the SmartBoard. (pal)
- Tell the students to remove the letter that makes the /l/ sound. Tell them to add the letter that makes the /n/ sound. Have a students come to the SmartBoard and do the same. (pan)
- Tell the students to remove the "p" and add the letter "t" (tan) Have a student come to the white board and do the same
- Tell the students to remove the beginning letter, and add the letters that make the same sound as the hear in the beginning of plan. Be sure the stretch out the /pl/. Have a student come to the board and do the same.
- Tell the students to add the letter "t" to make a word that means to place a seed in the ground so it will grow. (Plant)
