Pre-assessment:

• Students will be "quizzed" as a whole for the spelling of other Wacky Words (Word Wall). Those words will be from the day before, or if it is important to a story a particular word from further back.

Objectives:

• Students will be able to spell a word that is being added to the word wall after using multimodal practice activities.

LEARNING SEQUENCE

Time

INTO

Introduction/Motivation/Focus Attention

- Intorduce the "Word of the Week!," by showing the students the word on a piece of paper that has been cut to show the shape (tall-ness or small-ness) of all the letters in that word.
- Have the students repeat the word after you.
- Tell the students to clap it out, each letter should be said on the clap. For example (clap)"t"...(clap) "h"....(clap) "e'. Repeat 3 times

Time

THROUGH

Learning Activities (Input, Modeling, Check for Understanding, Guided Practice, Independent Practice)

- Have students turn to their neighbor on their left and write the word on their back with their finger. Saying each letter as they write it
- After all students have finished have them turn to their neighbor on their right and write the word on thier back, saying each letter as they write it.
- Hand out to all of the students a piece of black paper.
- In either white crayon, or chalk have each student write out the word.
- Using the "Sunrise" yarn that has already been precut have the students glue the yarn over their writting.
- After they have glued the yarn on the paper have the students come to the paper station and select one white piece of paper and 2 other colors taking 3 sheets of each other color.
- Tell the student to write the vowels (A,e,i,o,u) that are in the word on one color, and the consonats on the other.
- Instruct the students to cut out the letters and glue them onto the white sheet of paper.

BEYOND

Closure (Review/Check for Understanding/Summarize/Future forecast/Transition)

• Bring the class back together, and ask the students to close their eyes and spell the "Word of the Week!"
